Format	Narrative dance
Topic	A fable or story The story I am going to use is: _____
Important considerations:	Keep the movements simple so the audience will be able to follow the story. If possible, add props or costumes to augment the story.

Beginning	Create a short dance sequence (3-4 movements) to tell the beginning of the story. Use pictures and/or words to share your ideas. Tip: How will you start the dance piece? (e.g., enter from “off-stage”, begin in a tableau, etc.)

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Middle	<p>Create a short dance sequence (3-4 movements) to tell the middle of the story. Use pictures and/or words to share your ideas.</p>
End	<p>Create a short dance sequence (3-4 movements) to tell the end of the story. Use pictures and/or words to share your ideas.</p> <p>Tip: How will you signal your dance piece is finished? (e.g., take a bow, turn your back to the audience, exit “off-stage”, etc.)</p>
