Haudenosaunee perspectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Indigenous perspective is that land is sacred and can be shared.• This area of land is the Indigenous peoples land and it is compensation for the land they had lost in the American Revolution.• European colonizers settled on the lands without permission and Indigenous peoples had no way to remove them.• It was more than land, they took years of income.• Its not about the money, they want the land to be able to expand just as cities and towns do.

Government perspectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Land Back Lane is still on disputed territory and the government believes it belongs to the Crown.• They will meet with the community when they have time.
