

Inquiry Process – Human Settlements

Formulate questions related to the topic:

What do you want to know about this topic?

What do you know about your topic already?

What do I need to know?

What is the focus?

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Gather information about the topic using a variety of resources:

What kinds of resources would be helpful?

Consider if information is valid and accurate.

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<p>Interpret and analyze</p> <p>How does this information relate to my topic?</p> <p>How does it answer questions asked?</p> <p>Does it raise new questions?</p>	
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<p>Evaluate and draw conclusions</p> <p>Make informed and critical judgments about your evidence to help you answer your questions.</p>	
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Communicate your findings in an appropriate way (possible choices could be: visual presentation, series of diary entries, video, speech, etc.).

Who is your audience?

What is important?

What else can I connect my information with?

How will I express my message?
