Formulate Questions related to the topic:	
What do you want to know about this topic?	
What do you know about your topic already?	
What do I need to know?	
What is the focus?	

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Gather Information about the topic using a variety of resources:

What kinds of resources
would be helpful?

Consider if information
is valid and accurate

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Interpret and Analyse	
How does this information relate to my topic?	
How does it answer questions asked?	
Does it raise new questions?	
Evaluate and Draw Conclusions	
Make informed and critical judgments about your evidence to help you answer your questions.	

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Communicate your findings in an appropriate way (possible choices could be: visual presentation, series of diary entries, video, speech, etc.).

What else can I connect my information with?

How will I express my message?
