Growing Patterns

Let's follow the steps to create a growing pattern!

- 1. Choose a number between 1 to 4 (this will be your starting number).
- 2. Next, choose one of the following numbers to add to your starting number: 3, 9, or 11.
- For example, I chose to start at 2 and add 9 each time.
- Here is a growing pattern starting at 2 and adding 9 each time: 2, 11, 20, 29, 38, 47, 56...
- 3. State your pattern rule.

Use this statement: "Start at ____ and add ____ each time"

4. From your starting number, extend your pattern to a minimum of 8 terms forward.

- 5. You can represent your pattern on a number line or the hundred chart by placing the "plus" sticker onto the numbers from your pattern.
- What pattern do you notice? How would you describe it?
