Think!	What are some possible solutions? ## Ask, Think, Plan, & Share Activity

Plan!	Plan a design, and if possible, create a drawing that includes all materials you may need.	I can:  choose what I think will be the best solution  draw or create a detailed description of my design (i.e., What vegetables would you grow?)  add labels and materials that would be needed
Ask!	Does this solve the problem? Who will I need to consult?	I can:  • ask who you would need to discuss this plan with at the school (i.e., What questions would you ask them?)  • ask how I will know if this solves the problem
