| Impact | Description of impact |
|---------------|---|
| Social | reduces electricity rates for neighbours close to the project some complain about the sound and vibration caused by wind turbines |
| Economic | creates jobs and a new source of revenue for farmers in the form of land lease payments, and an increased local tax base attracts tourists to explore wind turbines in-person |
| Environmental | potential to reduce, fragment, or degrade habitat for wildlife, fish, and plants spinning turbine blades can pose a threat to flying wildlife |
| Costs | more expensive than other sources hard to find good locations to build that are close to cities cause noise impact local wildlife wind speeds are always changing; sometimes, it's not the most reliable source |
| Benefits | creates jobs cost-effective clean fuel source and does not emit any pollutants local source of energy and sustainable can be built on existing farms of land areas |
